White Extra Soft Eraser/Kneaded Eraser

Water Container (butter tub, cleaned thoroughly)

Spray Bottle

Old Bath Towel—for painting on.

Paper Towels (Viva)

Drawing Pencil

Bag for trash

**Watercolor Paper**—Arches Bright White 140#. You should only need 1-2 full sheets. We will be painting on 11 x 15 inch sheets. Please, **DO NOT** buy student grade paper in a pad such as Strathmore's.

**Watercolor Palette**—I prefer one without dividers in the mixing area.

**Watercolor Brushes**--#8 Round, 1½ inch Flat, #4 Round, #10 Round or Silver Black Velvet Jumbo Round Small

**Watercolor Paints** in tubes:

Permanent Yellow

Indian Yellow

Naples Yellow

Sap Green

Pthalo Green (Blue Shade)

Pthalo Blue (Red Shade)

Cerulean Blue

Cobalt Blue

Quinacridone Magenta

Opera or Hot Pink

Alizaren Crimson

Permanent Rose

Quinacridone Red

For professional grade paints, I recommend the following brands: Winsor Newton, Daler-Rowney, American Journey (Cheap Joe's brand). Student grade paint is another option, usually a bit cheaper, and I recommend Grumbacher Academy or Winsor & Newton Cotman. Order online through Cheap Joe's, Jerry's Artarama, or at your local arts & crafts store such as Hobby Lobby or Michaels. Sometimes they have 40% off coupons!
